Biography:

Professor Raustiala writes and teaches in the areas of international law and international relations. He holds a joint appointment between the UCLA Law School and the UCLA International Institute, where he teaches in the Program on Global Studies. Professor Raustiala's research focuses on international cooperation and conflict in areas such as environment, trade, armed conflict, dispute resolution, and intellectual property. He has been a visiting professor at Harvard, Columbia, Princeton, and Chicago. Prior to coming to UCLA he was a research fellow in the Foreign Policy Studies Program at The Brookings Institution, a Peccei Scholar at the International Institute for Applied Systems in Austria, and an assistant professor of politics at Brandeis University. His scholarship has been published in journals such as *World Politics*, *International Organization*, and the *American Journal of International Law*. He is also a frequent media contributor whose writing has been featured in the *New York Times*, the *Wall Street Journal*, the *Financial Times*, the *New Republic*, and the *New Yorker*.
