

## Neles Tebay

Neles Tebay was born on February 13, 1964 in West Papua. He is now a priest in the diocese of Jayapura, West Papua, Rector of Fajar Timur School of Philosophy and Theology in West Papua, and coordinator of Papua Peace Network promoting dialogue between the Government of Indonesia and Indigenous Papuans. From 1998 to 2000 he worked as a journalist for The Jakarta Post (an English-language daily published in the Indonesian capital of Jakarta). He was educated at the Fajar Timur School of Philosophy and Theology in Jayapura. He obtained his PhD in Missiology from the Pontifical Urban University in Rome in March 2006. The title of his PhD thesis was “The Reconciling Mission of the Church in West Papua in the Light of Reconciliatio et Paenitentia”.

He is the author of four books: (1) *West Papua: The struggle for peace with justice* published by the Catholic Institute for International Relations/CIIR, London, in 2005; (2) *Interfaith Endeavours for Peace in West Papua*: Aachen, Missio, 2006; (3) *Papua: Its Problems and possibilities for a peaceful solution*, Jayapura: SKP, 2008; (4) *Dialog Jakarta-Papua: Sebuah Perspektif Papua*, Jayapura: SKP, 2009 (Dialogue between Jakarta and Papua: a Perspective from Papua: Aachen/Germany, Missio, 2009 ).

He has been regular contributor for The Jakarta Post and Indonesian daily *Suara Pembaharuan* published in Jakarta, and Pasific Post published in Jayapura.

He has been guest speaker on Human Rights, Justice, Peace, and Multiculturalism, for at least 10 times outside Indonesia and at least 14 times in Indonesia.
