

SE A ST ADDITIONAL COURSES

Below you will find additional courses not included on the Major Worksheet that the Chair has approved for use towards the SE A ST major and minor for a particular quarter.

****NOTE:** Once you are enrolled in any of these courses, please contact the Advising Office at idsps@international.ucla.edu so that your DPR can be updated. Your DPR will not post any courses on this list towards your SE A ST major and minor requirements automatically! ** And, be sure to include your UID# in all correspondence. Thanks!

Having trouble enrolling in a particular class that is on this list or the Major or Minor Worksheet? Please check the Schedule of Classes for enrollment restrictions! Click on the course ID Number link to see what, if any, enrollment restrictions are listed for the course. Note that some departments restrict enrollment to students pursuing their majors on 1st pass (such as many courses in Sociology, History, Political Science, and others), but should open up to other majors on 2nd pass. If courses are already full at that point, you can always approach the instructor to see if s/he will give you a PTE#, or keep checking enrollment (especially through the 1st week of classes), to see if any spots open up.

Note that courses that are **multiple listed** appear with an 'M' in front of the course number on the Schedule of Classes. Multiple listed courses often have different enrollment restrictions, but enrolling in either course will count towards the same requirement. For example, the course description for History M184B indicates that it is the same course as Jewish Studies M184B and is listed separately on the Schedule of Classes under each of these departments and course numbers. If there are enrollment restrictions under one listing of the course, or one is already full, try enrolling in the other (check restrictions first!). Regardless of how you enroll, the DPR will apply either course towards the particular requirement it fulfills.
